- Resulting in Herne Bay Beach being cleared now




January 2023 Storms - 1

Herne Bay Needs a New Sewer - 1

Herne Bay Toilets and showers overflow into the harbour on 250 days every year! Meaning trunk sewer can't cope with normal household use.



Herne Bay Needs a New Sewer - 2

Hence new trunk sewer essential Part of Western Isthmus project partially funded by the Auckland wide Water Quality <u>Targeted</u> <u>Rate</u> finishing in 2028.



Herne Bay Needs a New Sewer - 3

WI combined sewer collection means either gets to Mangere Treatment or overflows from Meola, Motions, Cox's Creek or directly like Herne Bay into Waitemata Harbour





Herne Bay Needs a New Sewer – 3a



Central Interceptor – 4

Recent proposal Central Interceptor to run from Pt Erin to Mangere Plant expect reduced overflows 2-6pa approx 6 months rainfall event. Similar to separation expectation.



Central Interceptor – 5

CI collects water from all WI suburbs, Mt Eden, Mt Albert, Avondale, Waterview to Ponsonby, Grey Lynn, Herne/St Marys Bays Watercare can close WI doors if overfull. Then usual overflows into Waitemata



Sewage Separation and Tunnels – 6

Ian Wallis says there is insufficient information to confirm Watercare's stated outcome of 2-6 overflows pa. Recommends door at Tawariki St and early separation in Herne Bay



Sewage Separation and Tunnels – 7

Intensification means incremental separation inevitable in WI.



Herne Bay Needs a New Sewer – 8

Watercare sought resource consent Construction of new trunk sewer "Herne Bay Tunnel" - a major project. This 2.1M internal diameter pipe will run from Pt Erin to Marine Parade





Alignment of the Project (red lines), with the underlying zoning



Boring Machine (TBM) needs access for direction changes. Surface holes are drilled from the street to allow this.

Plus 4 maintenance shafts required.



Boring machine barely noticeable. But Shaft excavation will be noisy, and annoying with dewatering, vibration, and heavy vehicle traffic. Dewatering/vibration can be serious.



Watercare seeks property reports. HBRAI believes proposed reports not sufficiently comprehensive Repair statement needs unequivocal WC responsibility



Pt Erin and Salisbury parks proposed as construction sites Large Part of Salisbury park affected No evidence of mitigation attempts Or assessment of alternatives



HBRAI made extensive submissions WC resource consent application Discussions commencing
